The sale of native crafts that exploit their traditional use such as peace pipes, tomahawks or related items are prohibited. **Non-Indigenous people selling products misrepresented as “Indian made” would be in violation of the federal Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990 and could face fines of up to \$250,000 and a 5-year prison term if convicted.** The First Nations Student Organization reserves the right to deny vendor applicants a vendor space prior to, and/or the day of the Powwow for these or whatever reasons deemed necessary by the vendor applicant rules. **No refunds on vendor fees despite weather conditions.** Your signature below means you have completely read and understand the terms set by the First Nations Powwow Committee.
